

Dummy & Big Fat Dummy Rail Instructions

Hi there. Thanks for spending your hard-earned cash on this Surly product. Surly stuff is designed to be useful and durable. We're confident it will serve you well for years to come.

Surly Dummy Rails were designed to support our Dummy Deck and Dummy Bags. They fit all longtail frames (including the Big Dummy) using Xtracycle's design standards.

Our Dummy Deck bolts directly to the Dummy Rails using M5 metric hardware, unifying and stiffening the entire system. We include 20mm-long stainless steel flanged button head machine screws with the Dummy Rails for this application.

The threaded deck-attachment bosses, located along the tops of the Dummy Rails also serve as spacers. These 5mm-tall standoffs create space between the rails and the deck for bag straps, Junk Straps, webbing, and cords.

Threaded bosses, located at the rear of each rail, provide a mounting location for a water bottle cage or other accessories such as lights, cameras, action, pumps, flags, horns, light saber scabbards, disco balls, spittoons, cornucopias, etc.

Our Dummy Bags were designed to be fully compatible with our direct-mount rail and deck system. Non-Surly bags may or may not be compatible with our system, due to the placement of the threaded bosses on the rails.

We highly recommend you have your Dummy Rails installed by a competent professional bicycle mechanic.

△WARNING: Cycling can be dangerous. Bicycle products should be installed and serviced by a professional mechanic. Never modify your bicycle or accessories. Dummy & Big Fat Dummy Rail Compatibility and Intended Use

Surly Dummy Rails are compatible with Surly Dummy Bags, the Surly Dummy Deck, and the Surly Big Fat Dummy Deck. Surly Big Dummy Rails also fit all longtail frames using Xtracycle's design standards.

NOTE: Big Fat Dummy Rails are designed to be compatible with a maximum wheel size of 26×5.25 ". Big Dummy Rails are designed to be compatible with a maximum wheel size of 26×2.5 ".

BIG DUMMY

RETAILER: These instructions MUST BE provided to the end user.



INTENDED USE: CONDITION 2

This is a set of conditions for the operation of a bicycle that includes Condition 1 as well as unpaved and gravel roads and trails with moderate grades. In this set of conditions, contact with irregular terrain and loss of tire contact with the ground may occur. Drops are intended to be limited to $15 \, \mathrm{cm}$ (6") or less. BIG FAT DUMMY

RETAILER: These instructions MUST BE provided to the end user.



INTENDED USE: CONDITION 3

This is a set of conditions for operation of a bicycle that includes Condition 1 and Condition 2 as well as rough trails, rough unpaved roads, and rough terrain and unimproved trails that require technical skills. Jumps and drops are intended to be less than 61 cm (24"). Please see link to Bike Owner's Manual on surlybikes.com/safety for complete list of riding condition descriptions.

Safety

\triangle warning: failure to read and follow any of these safety warnings could cause a crash and serious injury

- The maximum load weight for the Dummy Cargo System is 200 lb (90 kg) 75 lb per bag plus 50 lb max load for the deck. Check with other manufacturer's systems to determine if they are compatible with the Dummy Cargo System maximum load weight. What you load and how you load it makes a big difference in how a bike like this handles! Use caution with unusually heavy, long, or large cargo
- Do not modify the luggage carrier in anyway. Hardware included with the rack must be used. Do not use hardware included on your bike
- Only carry live cargo if you are using Surly Rail Collars
- · Position reflectors and lights so that they are not obstructed when the rack is loaded
- . The bicycle may behave differently (particularly with regard to steering and braking) when the luggage carrier is loaded
- Make sure your load is evenly balanced and secure before every ride ride; always secure loose straps or cords or anything else that may get caught in the wheel prior to riding

Tools Needed

Grease

Parts Included

• (8) M5 x 0.8 x 20mm stainless flanged button head socket cap screws (for Dummy or Big Fat Dummy Deck installation, see Deck Instructions for proper assembly)

Installation

- Apply a small amount of grease to the exterior surface of each rail tube where the rail will be inserted into the longtail vertical frame tubes.
- 2. Insert the front part of the rail (the end without bottle cage bosses) into the front vertical Big Dummy frame tube. It will go into the frame 15mm before the rear part of the rail can be inserted. Apply light downward pressure to both ends of the rail, alternating between the front and rear, until both ends hit their dead stops and are fully seated in the frame.
- You are now ready to install the Dummy Bags and the Dummy Deck onto the rails.



Ongoing Maintenance

If you lack proper tools, knowledge, or patience to get the job done right, visit your friendly local bike mechanic for assistance. Spare parts are available in the event that you break or lose something.

Your new Dummy Rails require little maintenance. Periodically check the tightness of the hardware. Spray a little oil inside the tubes on occasion, if you're prone to riding in wet conditions.

 \triangle WARNING: Improper installation of bolts may lead to product failure, causing serious injury. Do not exceed specified torque values. Periodically inspect bolts and retighten if required.

Frequently check to make sure that all of the rack hardware is properly torqued per these instructions. Check to make sure that the rack mounting bolts are properly tightened and secure the rack to the bicycle frame. Periodically check for any signs of cracking or failure and discontinue use if rack is damaged.

Limited Warranty

This Surly product is warranted against defects in materials and workmanship for one year from the date of retail purchase of the product, subject to the limitations detailed below. Save your dated receipt for proof of purchase.

This warranty does NOT cover the following:

- Damage due to improper assembly or follow-up maintenance or lack of skill, competence or experience of the user or assembler
